Dear Parent/Guardian:

The safety of your children is our number one concern and "The Safe Rider Program" is a student management program which promotes and teaches proper school bus safety. The core of the program promotes personal accountability as it relates to bus safety because unsafe choices endanger the safety of all passengers.

How the Program Works

The program promotes instant accountability for unsafe behavior as shown below.

The program also includes a defined and graduated discipline plan. The concept does not stop here. We have also developed a Safe Rider Class that employs several different ways of empowering the student to correct unsafe behavior. Some of those techniques include role play, videos and class work which will be scheduled to not interfere with the student's academic work.

Unsafe Behavior on the Ride Home

> If unsafe behavior occurs before the bus leaves the school; the student will be provided with two options: (1) Correct the behavior and continue home (behavior documented) or (2) be removed from the bus and taken to MCAA with staff supervision until a parent or guardian can pick up the student (behavior documented.)

 \succ If unsafe behavior occurs after the bus leaves the school the driver will contact their Dispatch. Transportation staff will assess the situation and if necessary, a staff member will remove the student from the bus to return the student to MCAA to remain under staff supervision until a parent or guardian can pick the student up.

> If either of the above instances occurs, the graduated discipline plan will be in effect.

Also the MCS j-Policies for students supersede the Safe Rider Program.

We need your partnership as we move forward in making Marietta City School buses safer and more enjoyable part of the student's day. Please review the *Safe Rider Policies and Regulations* with your student. Please complete and sign the *Safe Rider Contract / Emergency Form* with your child and return to your bus driver within 5 days to continue bus rider privileges and to insure your child's assigned seat.

GRADUATED DISCIPLINE PLAN

• **1st Offense –** Driver Student Conference & Parent Contacted. (Courtesy Notice.) Student on probation and re-assigned to the front of Bus for 1 week.

• **2nd Offense –** Driver Student Conference & Parent Contacted. (Courtesy Notice.) Student on probation and re-assigned to the front of Bus for 2 weeks.

• **3rd Offense*** – Referral submitted, **3 Days Bus Suspension**. Upon return student placed on probation and re-assigned to the front of Bus for 1 week. *Safe Rider Class and Behavior Contract Required.

• 4th Offense* – Referral submitted, 5 Days Bus Suspension. *Conference required before returning to the school bus.

<u> 5th Offense – Referral submitted, Transportation Director recommends Bus suspension for the remainder of the year.</u>

Policies and regulations of behavior for safety of the passenger

- 1. Students who are being transported on MCS buses, must always show respect to the bus drivers by following the instructions given; as well as all **"SAFE RIDER"** contract rules. All students must comply with reasonable instructions given by *any* employee of the Marietta City Schools system. Failure to do so is considered an act of insubordination.
- 2. All Marietta students must provide the correct personal information (i.e. name, grade, contact number, parent's name, etc.) if an employee of the Marietta City School system asks for their information.
- 3. Students of primary and middle schools will be assigned a seat on a school bus. (*High school assigned seating may be required at the discretion of the school bus driver*). During transportation, students **must** remain seated at all times.
- 4. Students are required to be at their bus stop **no less than least five (5) minutes** before their scheduled pick up time. Students must wait at the stop in an orderly manner. When crossing the street, students must **wait for** instructions (signal by hand) by the driver. Students must physically look at the school bus driver, and cross in full view of the driver when instructed to do so.
- 5. Students may use cell phones while on the bus, but at no time are they allowed to use phones for taking pictures, recording audio, or creating videos. All other electronic device to include, iPads, notebooks, etc., can be used with headphones only, and should not be overheard by others. <u>IMPORTANT</u>: Students shall not have headphones on or earbuds in their ears while loading or unloading the school bus. Students must be able to hear the driver of the bus at all times. <u>Under no circumstances should students use any electronic device to record video or audio while they are on the school bus.</u>
- 6. At the conclusion of the school day, students must immediately board their bus. Once on the bus, students are not allowed to disembark the bus unless directed by a school administrator in emergency cases only. Students getting off the bus without permission may be required to find alternate transportation as buses will be released at their regular time.
- 7. Students must get on and off the school bus at their bus stop <u>only</u>. If students miss their bus, parents must transport student to school, and not to another bus stop. Alternative transportation arrangements must be submitted in writing to the school for approval; and, a *bus pass* must be given to the driver signed by school administration before alternate transportation is approved.
- 8. Students must remain completely **quiet** and **silence all noise making devices at all** railroad crossings until the bus completely crosses the railroad tracks. Extremely loud talking, and the use of noise making devices is prohibited on the school bus.
- Due to the possibility of allergic reactions and/or chocking: food items, chewing gum, candy, chocolates, and sodas cannot be opened and/or consumed while on the school bus. Water is allowed during extreme heat temperatures; but containers must have sealable lids.
- 10. Tobacco products, illegal drugs and/or alcoholic items are **not** permitted at the bus stop, on the bus or on school grounds at any time.
- 11. No guns, knives, (*or objects that appear to be or can be used as weapons*) are allowed at the bus stop, on the bus, or on school grounds at any time. Dangerous and/or combustible items are not allowed on the school bus. Items containing glass, lighters or matches, animals, balloons, flowers/plants, perfume/cologne, aerosol spray containers, plastic bags, insects, pins of any sort, sharp objects, large toys, objects that cannot be comfortably placed on the lap of the student or any other dubious object that can represent a security risk are prohibited and shall not be brought onto the school bus at any time.
- 12. *Fighting and Bullying on the school bus, or at the school bus stop is strongly prohibited*. No play fighting, horse playing, or any inappropriate and/or suspicious acts or gestures will be allowed. Obscene language, physical or verbal harassment, intimidation of any sort, threats or abuses of any kind are also prohibited on the school bus and at the school bus stop.
- 13. Destruction and/or vandalism on any part of the school bus is prohibited. The costs and replacement of all damages will be the sole responsibility of the student(s) and/or family of the student(s) responsible for the damages.
- 14. Students shall not use mirrors, x-ray lasers, flashlights, or any other light or surface that reflects light as these may distract or interfere with the driver's ability to safely operate the school bus.
- 15. Musical instruments used in band, sports team equipment, and projects for school classes can <u>only</u> be transported if there is room enough <u>after</u> all students have been properly seated. These objects can be placed on the seat, under the seat, or on the lap of the person to whom they belong. *Skate Boards are not allowed on buses.* Students must also keep their personal items secured, and all physical body parts must remain inside the school bus at all times.

Safe Rider Contract/Emergency Form

If your student is going to take advantage of their bus riding privilege, please complete legibly, and sign the Safe Rider Contract / Emergency Form with your child, then **return to your bus driver within 5 days to continue bus rider privileges** and receive your child's assigned seat.
